## Beginning of the 17-18 School Year



### FAQs

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**Q: When does car line/drop off begin in the morning?**

A: 7:00am. It is ENCOURAGED that parents have their child ride the school bus as often as possible. With 800 plus students at our school, the most efficient way to arrive on time is via the school bus. Car line will begin at 7:00am. Cars must line up on Rene St. as close to the right side of the street as possible. We have 17 large school busses that will need to have room to pass on the left.

**Q: What time can my child be on campus in the morning?**

A: 7:00am

**Q: Where do parents drop off their child in the morning?**

A: Parents must drop their child off in the front of school by car line only on Cedar Street. Please do not drop your child off on Rene Street.

**Q: Where do parents pick up their child in the afternoon?**

A: Parents can begin to line up for car line at 2:15pm on the far right of Rene Street. Busses will need access to get around car line. Once all busses are loaded following dismissal car line will move to pick up the students on Cedar Street in front of the school. Please watch for duty teachers as they will direct you to the appropriate pick point. Our goal is to provide you with the most efficient and timely car line experience.

**Q: Will my 6<sup>th</sup> grader have a chance to meet their teachers before August 10<sup>th</sup>?**

A: Yes, we will have an Open House on August 8th from 3:00-5:00pm. Students can pick up their schedule, check out your classrooms, meet your teachers, and purchase uniforms. Students who preordered a school supply kit and/or school uniforms can pick up those on the same day. Parents please remember that teachers are working to prepare for the first day of school. This event will begin in the Gym. Students and parents will then follow student schedules in order to meet each classroom teacher. This will serve as Orientation and Open House for 6<sup>th</sup> graders in 2017-2018. Once the school year begins, please be sure to frequently check teacher websites weekly and communicate any questions or concerns directly with your child's teachers.

**Q: When will my student get their schedule?**

A: 6<sup>th</sup> graders who attend Open House will receive their schedule during that time. All 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will receive their schedules on the first day of school.

**Q: When is the school office open and what are the school day hours?**

A: The school office opens at 7am and closes at 3pm daily. Our official school day begins at 7:26am and ends at 2:26pm.

**Q: What can my child get involved with at the school?**

A: We offer a variety of clubs for all students on campus. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders can also get involved in Athletics.

**Q: Where can I find more information about the school?**

A: There are many ways to get more information. Please check our website, call the school, or email. We have placed the schools policy handbook online for easy access. Many of your questions can be answered there, as well.

**Q: What can my child wear to school?**

A: Madisonville Junior has a dress code policy that is in accordance with STPSB's dress code. Please refer to our handbook with the specifics. One major change this year, is that all sweatshirts/outwear/etc. needs to be solid black or solid white. Sweatshirts/hoodies may be purchased with the MJH Logo. Small logos from other brands are acceptable. Large emblems are not acceptable. With any questions please contact the administration.

**Q: Where does my child start his or her day?**

A: 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> graders report to the gym daily and remain in the gym until 7:26am. Students will then directly report to their 1<sup>st</sup> period. 8<sup>th</sup> graders will meet in the cafeteria/cafeeteria picnic area. All students who eat breakfast will directly report to the cafeteria.

**Q: Why does my child have an ID?**

A: All MJH students must wear an ID daily. IDs are important for safety, use in the library, and used for lunches in the cafeteria. Students who lose their ID will need to purchase another ID for \$5. Students who forget their IDs must purchase another "Temporary ID" for \$1 daily. Students without \$1 will serve a morning detention.
